Clevedale Station

Clevedale Station is owned by Simon and Lindy Molesworth and is located about a ten minute drive from Broken Hill towards Menindee (it adjoins their Rupee Station off the Wilcannia Road).

Lindy is an environmental horticulturist, geologist and botanist and has a great love for the land. The Molesworths have sought to manage their two properties sustainably, intent on safeguarding the native vegetation. Lindy has been kind enough to offer not only her land but also her knowledge by giving a guided botanical paddock walk across parts of Clevedale Station.
