Some amazing field trips will be one of the real highlights of the 2019 NSW Landcare and Local Land Services conference as delegates head out into the landscapes in the iconic far west!

Delegates will be transported to one of four unique field trips, all which have their own appeal - you can choose which field trip you attend when you register. There is set capacity with each field trip so to avoid missing out on the field trip of your choice it is best to register early.

Historic Day Dream Mine, Silverton

The Historic Day Dream Mine is located north west of Silverton and approximately 28 kilometres from Broken Hill. It was first established in 1882 and despite being short-lived, attracted a sizeable settlement of around 500 people, as well as the district's first smelters.

Attendees will be treated to both a surface tour of the area and the old township as well as an underground tour of the mine. Sturdy walking shoes are suggested for this field trip.

The underground portion is not recommended for those who suffer from claustrophobia, as the tunnels get very narrow and low at times.
